Reentry

- Key to rendering criminal gangs ineffectual
- Florida has a model for reentry
- Lacking infrastructure
- Reentry is gaining momentum



Reentry Matrix

Pre release Juvenile	Pre release Adult
(Age < 21)	(Age > 18)
Post release Juvenile	Post release Adult
Community Juvenile	Community Adult



Reentering Gang Members

- Community led model (67 coalitions)
- Community can develop best practices and they must be measured
- Former gang members should be involved in the process of reentry
- Removal of some statutory restrictions for employment/education/housing



Elements of Reentry

- Education
- Involvement of Family
- Transitional 'step down'
- Vocational/Job Training
- Commitment to Individualized Reentry Plan
- Specialized Reentry Services
- Collaborative Planning
- Intensive Supervision
- Evidence-Based Intervention Curriculum



Funding

- Strategy Focuses Coordination of Funding
- Leverage Existing Resources
- Aggressively Pursue New Federal, State, Local Money/Grants
